Instructions for Petitions for the Degrees of Masonry

What to do:

You (the petitioner) fill out the Petition for the Degrees of Masonry, and return it to your sponsors, who will present them to the Lodge. Your petition must be accompanied by your check or money order for the amount of the petitioning fee (see below).

Before your petition can be voted on, the results of a background check must also be completed. You are responsible for the Background Verification fee. (**\$14.95**) Which is paid to the Verification Company. A Video walkthrough is available at brlodge.org/bgcheck

1. Scroll down to the link that says Background Verification Site
2. Click Apply Now
3. Select MEMBERSHIP (\$14.45) and click Continue
4. Fill out the form, agree, and click Continue
5. Finish page 2 of the form, and for Location - specify **Broad Ripple**

The verification process will NOT work properly on a cell phone or tablet for security reasons. Please use a computer when filling out your information.

What happens next?

Your sponsors will bring your petition to the next Stated Meeting (business meeting) of the Lodge, where it will be read aloud to the members present. If it is decided to receive your petition, a committee on character consisting of three Master Masons, members of this Lodge, will be appointed to meet with you. While they will undoubtedly have questions to ask of you, you may also feel free to ask questions of them, which they will endeavor to answer so far as they may do so. (For instance, they will not answer specific questions about the three degrees.)

In the meantime, your petition will lay over for one month until the next Stated Meeting of the Lodge. It will again be read aloud to the members present, and the committee on character will give their individual reports. Your petition will then be voted on in a secret ballot by the members present, who will each cast a

white ball (yes) or a black cube (no) on the question. Your petition must receive a unanimous white ball vote in order for you to be elected.

Once you are elected by the Lodge to receive the Degrees of Masonry, you will receive a formal notice from the Secretary of the Lodge along with a pamphlet called "Welcome to Freemasonry: General Information About Freemasonry For the Candidate and his Family." As suggested by its title, this pamphlet is for your entire family to read (should they so choose), and explains many of the basic premises of Freemasonry. (You will probably also receive a phone call almost immediately from your sponsor when you are elected. In this Lodge we take such things very seriously.) At this time we will also schedule your First, or Entered Apprentice, Degree.

The Petitioning Fee

The Lodge's petitioning fee, which covers the cost of conferral of the three Masonic Craft Degrees, is **\$150**. This fee includes a \$10 donation to the George Washington Masonic National Memorial in Alexandria, Virginia, which is mandated by the Grand Lodge of Indiana. *Your check or money order will not be cashed unless and until you are elected.* If your petitioning fee is not received with your petition, your petition will be held up until the fee is received.

Please note -- the petitioning fee does not include Lodge Dues!

In addition to the petitioning fee, you will have to pay Lodge dues -- but not until after you have taken the third degree and become a full voting member of the Lodge. In Indiana, all Master Masons are liable for dues as of the date they are raised to that degree. Therefore, please note that, *upon being raised to the degree of Master Mason*, you will be billed for pro-rata dues for the current year based on the month in which you are raised. Broad Ripple Lodge's annual dues as of January 1, 2024, are \$180. Pro-rata dues are calculated based on the month you were raised:

However -- keep in mind that dues for the next year are due on December 31st of this year. So if you are raised in December, don't let the zero dues fool you, because you will owe a full year's on the last day of this year.

Also, I certify all information contained on this application to be accurate as of the date of my signature and acknowledge that any inaccuracies may void this application.

As the exact nature of the Institution of Freemasonry is unknown to you, it is deemed advisable that before signing the attached petition you should be informed on certain phases of that Institution, which may affect your decision to apply for membership therein.

Freemasonry has in all ages required that men should come to its door entirely of their own free will; not as the result of importunity nor from feelings of curiosity; but from a favorable opinion of the Institution, a desire for knowledge, and a sincere wish to be serviceable to their fellow creatures.

Masonry is a system of morality based on the belief in the existence of a Supreme Being, the immortality of the soul, and the brotherhood of men; therefore, no atheist can be made a Mason. It strives to teach a man the duty he owes to his God, to his country, to his family, to his neighbor, and to himself. It inculcates the practice of every virtue and makes an extensive use of symbolism in its teachings. It interferes with neither religion nor politics, but strives only after light and truth, endeavoring always to bring out the highest and noblest qualities of men.

The Masonic Fraternity is in no sense an insurance society; neither does it pay benefits in case of sickness or death. In a correct and broad sense, it is both educational and charitable. It extends such assistance only as it is willing and able to grant. It knowingly admits none to membership except those who are able to provide for themselves and those dependent upon them.
